Fire Rips Through Historic Jersey Shore Bar

SOMERS POINT, N.J. -- A three-alarm fire ripped through a historic bar at the Jersey Shore Monday morning.

Flames ate through the 118-year-old Anchorage Tavern on Bay Avenue in Somers Point, N.J.
